Together with Stó:lō associated tribes, in particular the q̓'w:á:nl̓əh̓ (Kwantlen), q̓ičəy̓ (Katzie), Máthxwi (Matsqui) and Se'mya'me (Semiahmoo), we are building a strong community through honour and respect within our Traditional Territory.

ABBOTSFORD

THE HEART OF THE FRASER VALLEY

The Halq'eméylem name for Abbotsford is Selwí:chel, the "centre of something" or "middle of three." The ridge of Abbotsford overlooks the territories of the Semá:th to the east, the Máthxwi to the north and the Nexwseq to the south. Nestled on the flatlands between the Coast and Cascade Mountain Ranges, Abbotsford was first inhabited by the Stó:lō First Nations, followed by European settlers fresh from the Gold Rush.

The sight of towering blue mountains so close you could touch them. The smell of rows and rows of tulips, or freshly baked bread wafting down the sidewalk. The feel of your head hitting the pillow after a day exploring one of the most beautiful places on earth. The Fraser Valley is a true feast for every one of your senses. In the following pages, we invite you to come visit us, experience the pure magic of the Valley, and awaken your senses to places they may never have been before.



LIFE CYCLE OF THE SALMON

In the Lower Fraser (Stó:lō) region, the life cycle of the salmon weaves into the natural rhythms of the land. As it does with the salmonberry (elílá:lhp in Halq'eméylem), a key indicator of seasonal changes that guide the salmon's life stages.

When the salmonberry plant flowers in Spring, the first salmon of the year begin their journey upriver. As the berries mature, so do the fish, until salmon navigate their final stretch just as salmonberries finish for the season. When leaves on the salmonberry plant fall, salmon finally spawn, completing their life cycle before the process begins anew.

As the salmon expire, nutrients from their bodies nourish the land and other species, making the salmon's journey vital to the Fraser River's ecosystem—just as sure as the salmonberry blooms on its banks.

WITNESS SALMON SPAWNING

INCH CREEK FISH HATCHERY

Produces Coho, Sockeye, Chum, Steelhead for a number of local tributaries that lead to the Fraser River. It is also home to two large sturgeon — Henry and Arnold. | **Mission**

CHILLIWACK RIVER HATCHERY

A key facility for salmon conservation, the hatchery plays a vital role in sustaining local salmon populations for commercial, sport, and First Nations fisheries. Visitors can explore a self-guided trail to see salmon at various stages of development and witness the critical work being done to support this essential species. | **Chilliwack**

GREAT BLUE HERON NATURE RESERVE

Home to over 150 Great Blue Heron nests, this nature reserve presents a wonderful opportunity to connect with nature. Besides the abundant birdwatching, visitors can also view salmon spawning in its streams, making for a unique glimpse into the vibrant ecosystems that thrive here. | **Chilliwack**

PEACH CREEK TRAIL

Just off the Vedder Rotary Trail is a prime location to view salmon spawning and learn more about our local ecosystem. Starting at the Lickman Road trailhead, stroll through lush surroundings to the peaceful spawning channel to witness the incredible journey of the salmon as they return to their birthplace. | **Chilliwack**

SEASON OF THE WILD

The Season of the Wild tells the story of the salmon, sturgeon, and the eagles here in Harrison Mills. Every year, the salmon swim up the Harrison River and come to rest in our tributaries to lay their eggs. The spawning season typically begins mid-October, with prime viewing October through early November. | **Harrison River Valley**

INDIGENOUS CULTURE

The Fraser Valley exists as part of the traditional lands of the Stó:lō, which in the Halq'eméylem language, translates as “People of the River.” Stó:lō is also the name for what is referred to as the Fraser River. The Stó:lō are part of the larger Coast Salish, whose oral history maintains “We have always been here.” Through core cultural elements including Sxwoxwiyám (narratives of the distant past; accounts of the Transformers), Sqwélqwel (true news; individual and family histories) and Shxwéli (interconnected spirit, life force), the Stó:lō maintain close connections to the land, water and resources of S’ólh Téméxw (Our Land, Our World), to which strong caretaking stewardship obligations are maintained through core traditional teachings.

salishan Place by the River is Langley’s new cultural centre and home of the museum and Fort Langley Library. Currently under construction with a planned opening in 2025, it will provide indoor and outdoor community gathering spaces, including a reception hall and presentation theatre. 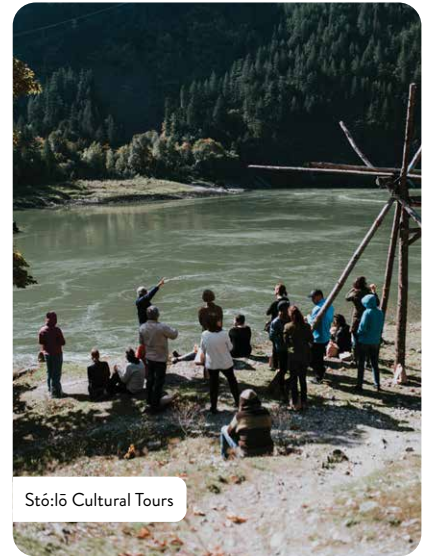

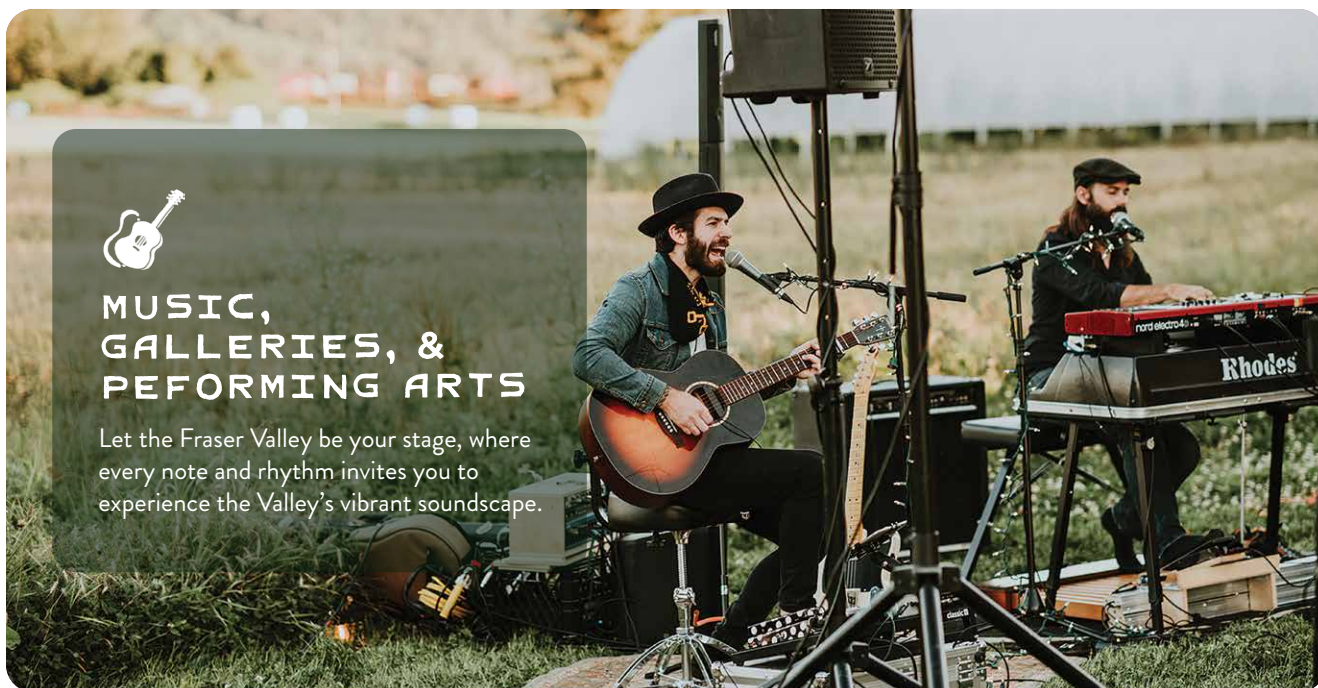

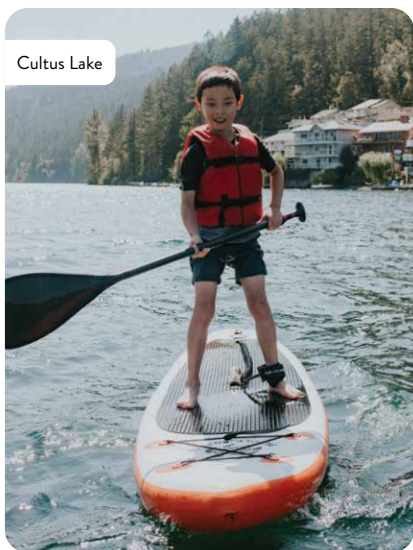

For the catch of a lifetime, visitors from all around the world visit the Fraser Valley—a world-class sport fishing destination that presents an opportunity for year-round fishing experiences for novices and experts alike!

FISH OF THE FRASER VALLEY

The Fraser Valley is home to a wide variety of fishing, from calm lakes to wild rivers, for a wide variety of species including Salmon, Steelhead, Rainbow Trout, Bull Trout, Dolly Varden, and Sturgeon. Anglers use many methods of fishing such as spinning gear, casting and single and double-handed fly fishing.

FISHING FOR STURGEON

The mighty Fraser River is home to a big game prehistoric giant dinosaur, the **White Sturgeon!** They have survived two ice-ages and are still living in the Fraser River. It is the largest freshwater species in North and South America and can reach over 20 feet in length and live well over 150 years in both fresh and saltwater. Monster sturgeon have been caught, recorded and released, unharmed by local conservation-minded fishing companies.



FISHING REGULATIONS

It is the angler's responsibility to read and understand the B.C. fishing regulations. Please fish ethically and handle fish with care. These laws exist to protect our fish stocks and maintain an ecological balance within our environment. The Fraser Valley is also the heart of some of the richest fishing grounds in the world, where all 5 different species of **Pacific salmon** (Chinook, Sockeye, Chum, Coho and Pink) migrate, with annual run sizes that can be upwards of 40 million. The Fraser River Corridor in the Fraser Valley is the most delicate and rich ecosystem for our wild salmon and sturgeon on the entire 1,375 km river.

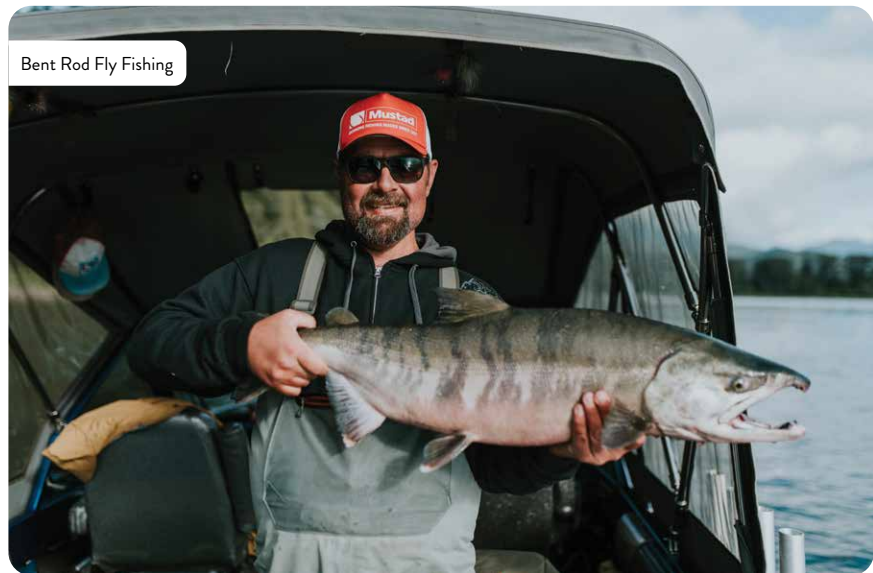

Running alongside the Fraser River from Langley to Harrison Lake, the Fraser Valley Bird Trail is part of the Pacific Flyway that sees more than 200 distinct species visiting throughout the year to perch above the abundant waters, rich marshland and bountiful salmon available here. GETTING HERE!

AIRPORT

The Abbotsford International Airport (YXX) is the primary airport in the Fraser Valley region. With its central location, it is a quick, hassle-free alternative to the Vancouver International Airport (YVR) for both Fraser Valley and north of the Fraser communities.

PASSPORTS

All international persons who enter Canada from any foreign destination by air, land or sea are required to have a valid national passport and may also require a visa. US citizens entering Canada are not required to present a passport, however you should carry proof of citizenship such as a birth certificate, certificate of citizenship or naturalization, as well as photo ID.

Aldergrove Crossing (Langley)

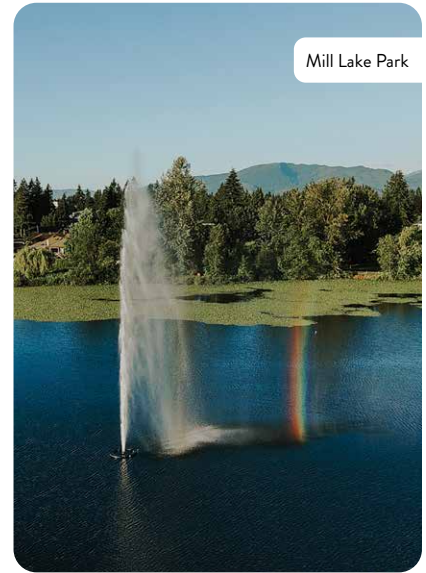

Contributing factors include the close proximity to the Pacific Ocean and the protection of the spectacular Coastal Mountain range.

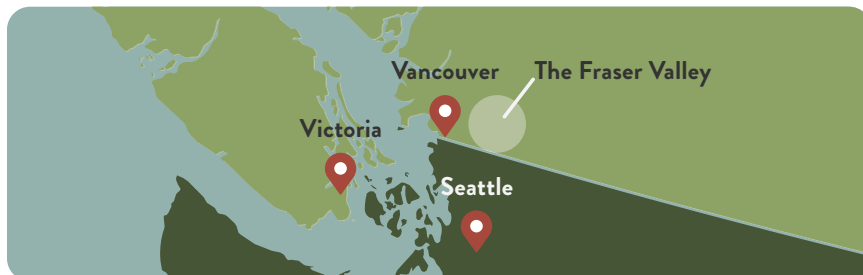
